### **New Air-Con for St Lawrence Church**

As you know, in the last few weeks we have had some hot days. It was noticed and experienced by everyone who came to St Lawrence Church as our old evaporative air-conditioning system does not cope well enough with hot and humid weather. The advice from the repair company is not to spend any more money on this old system and replace it with split units. The whole matter of the air-conditioning system in the church was discussed at our Finance Committee some months ago and it has been agreed that this issue needs to be addressed in the near future. It looks like the time has come to undertake the replacement project now. We have decided to install Solar panels on all three buildings (Church, Alverna Hall and Presbytery) and then install the new split system in the church. The installation of the solar panels will take place this week. *If* you would like to contribute towards this major project for the church please use the special envelopes marked 'New Air-Con for St Lawrence Church' and place it into the second collection basket at Mass.
