Ordinary Time in Liturgy



Ordinary Time, depending on the year, runs either 33 or 34 weeks. Basically, Ordinary Time encompasses that part of the Christian year that does not fall within the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent or Easter.

The Catholic Church celebrates two periods of the year as

Ordinary Time. The first period begins after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (the Sunday after The Epiphany has ended). The next Sunday is still reckoned "The Second Sunday in Ordinary Time" because it is the Sunday of the second week in Ordinary Time.

The reckoning can be confusing, and had many asking "What happened to the first Sunday in Ordinary Time?" This first period of Ordinary Time runs until the Tuesday evening before Ash Wednesday. The Second period of Ordinary Time runs from the Monday after Pentecost until Evening Prayer is said the night before Advent begins. This includes Christ the King, the final Sunday of Ordinary Time. In some denominations, the Sundays of the second period of Ordinary Time are numbered "Sundays after Pentecost".
