Alpha and Omega, beginning and end

But if all this calendar development says anything, it is this: the Church is alive, constantly growing in its understanding of the truths of the Faith (as evidenced in the expansion of the Temporal Cycle) and constantly renewing itself by producing more and more models of Christian holiness (as seen in our multitude of feasts of the Sanctoral Cycle).

The Church's categories of celebrations—from the greatest solemnities like Easter and Christmas, to the lesser feasts like the Presentation and Transfiguration, to the stream of memorials of the saints, both obligatory and optional—tells us that the Church as the Mystical Body of Christ only reflects the eternal, day-in and day-out nature of her Founder.

Advent ties our Church time together: it is both a looking backward to Christ's historical birth 200 years ago, and a looking forward to his coming again at the end of historical time. And that, in a nutshell, is the story of the Church's year. As the priest solemnly intones while marking the Paschal candle: Christ yesterday and today, the beginning and the end, Alpha and Omega; all time belongs to him, and all the ages; to him be glory and power, through every age for ever. Amen.
