# **Understanding the Eucharist today**

Here is another article to help you refresh, and deepen your understanding and appreciation of the Eucharist by reflecting on different parts and aspects of the Mass.

# Part II— The Listening....continued

After the readings have been proclaimed, the priest seeks to break open the Word we have heard through the homily. 'Homily' refers to a form of preaching that is based on the Word, not just on a topic the preacher would like to expound. The homily continues the process by which God speaks to us, applying the ancient scriptural Word to the situations of our own time and place. That Word speaks to us both as individuals and as a community; the preacher's task is to help us understand both dimensions of God's Word. That task is not the preacher's alone, however. The assembly must engage in active listening to apply the Word to their own lives. After each of the first two readings and again after the homily, there is a brief pause for a silent reflection on what has been heard and how it applies to the lives of the hearers.

That active listening is a skill that has been neglected in recent years. With habits retained from the days of the Latin Mass, when it was necessary to have a missal to follow along in English, many worshippers still try to read along with the reader instead of listening with open ears and open hearts. While it may be necessary for those who are hard of hearing to have books to follow, the normal practice should involve attentive listening to trained lectors, using good sound systems if necessary. Having their own texts puts the hearers in control of the event. They can speed up, slow down, reread or skip over sections. Active listening, on the other hand, surrenders control to the voice of God as it comes through the reader, which is the appropriate spiritual stance to meet the Lord. The proclamation of the Word of God is not a time for reading and study, but a time for a spiritual encounter with the living Word from a living Christ speaking through the reader. The assembly should give the reader their undivided attention.
