Understanding the Eucharist today


Here is another article to help you refresh, and deepen your understanding and appreciation of the Eucharist by reflecting on different parts and aspects of the Mass.

Part II— The Listening....continued

The Breaking of the Bread follows the Sign of Peace. This action, preparing to share the one loaf, gave its name to the whole Eucharist in early times ("they gathered for the breaking of bread"). It is a sign of our communion in the one Christ. As congregations grew larger, the breaking took some time, and the 'Lamb of God' was sung to accompany this action. The Missal of 1970 says that the Eucharistic bread "should therefore be made in such a way that the priest can break it and distribute the parts to at least some of the faithful. The gesture of the breaking of the bread will more clearly show the Eucharist as a sign of unity and charity, since the one bread is being distributed among the members of one family".

Sharing Communion is the climax of the Eucharist. Before we come to the table, we acknowledge our unworthiness ("Lord, I am not worthy") and rejoice in the fact that God does not require us to be worthy but heals us by his Word. This is the same Jesus who scandalised the religious leaders of his time by sharing meals with sinners. He continues to do the same today. None of us are worthy of this meal; we share in it by God's gracious invitation.
