Plenary Council 2020

Pope Francis has given his approval for the Catholic Church to hold the first Plenary Council—the most significant national gathering that can be held—in Australia in more than 80 years and has appointed Archbishop Costelloe as president of the Council. The Archbishop encourages all Catholics, whether devout or disillusioned, fervent or frustrated, to seize the opportunity to speak what is on their minds and in their hearts. The process of listening and dialogue begins at Pentecost 2018 and is a time for us to explore together how we might answer the question: 'What do you think God is asking of us in Australia?', as the Church faces significant challenges.
