20th Annual Rally For Life—Sat 26th May Supreme Court Gardens 6.30pm to 8pm Sat 26th May will mark a sad day—the 20th anniversary of the legalisatin of abortion in WA. Over the last 20 years 165,000 WA children (over 8000 in one year) have been deprived of life. The theme of this year's Rally for Life (which will include a commemorative service) is Love Them Both. We will mourn the loss of tens-of-thousands

of children's lives under WA's callous legislation, as well as acknowledge the profound and enduring pain experienced by many women and other people directly or indirectly involved in abortion. As a poignant reminder of the loss of life, 3300 white crosses (each representing 50 children) will be displayed in the form of a giant cross. In order to comfort those who have been harmed in any way by abortion, red roses will be provided to place beside crosses. The tone of the rally and service will be respectful and solemn.
